1. High school diploma or equivalent (G.E.D.); and
2. One (1) year of experience in the operation of light equipment relating to construction, maintenance or repair of water distribution systems, sanitary/storm sewer collection systems and/or roadways, or equivalent; and
3. Possess a valid Ohio Driver's License*; and
4. Possess a minimum of a Class B Ohio Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with tanker endorsement or obtain within 6 months of position appointment*; and
5. Must be able to respond within a reasonable amount of time to emergencies and fulfill physical demands of the position; and
6. Must be able and willing to work extended hours and demonstrate a work history of reliable attendance and over time response.
